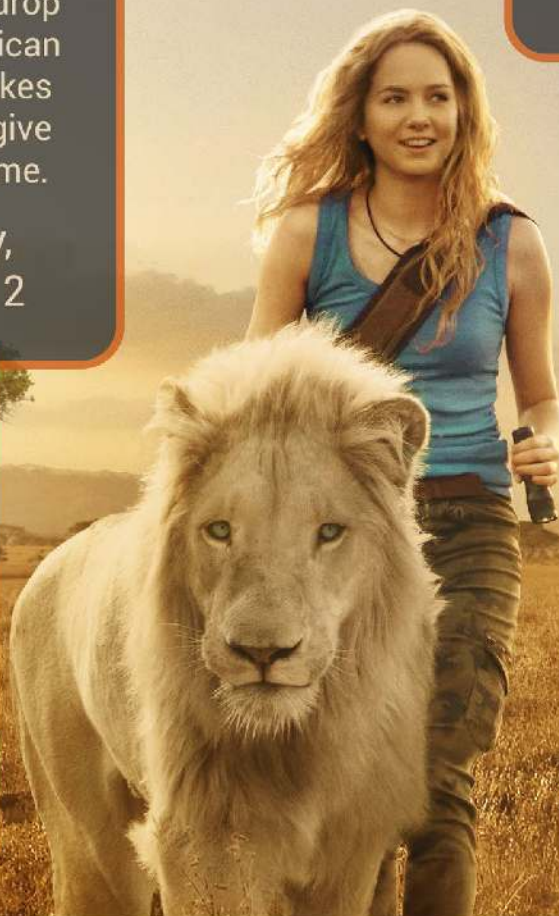

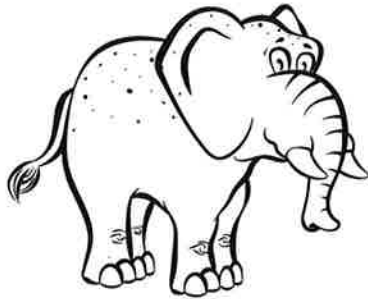

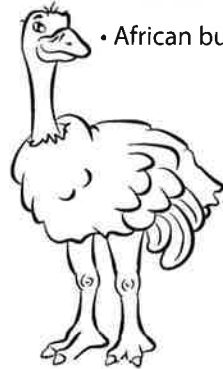

Did You Know



- The roar of a lion can be heard from 5 miles away!
- The name for a baby lion is a cub, whelp or lionet!
- In the wild, lions rest for around 20 hours a day!
- Female lions, sisters, live together for life. Their female cubs also stay with the pride, even after they're grown, but male cubs must go out on their own!
- The lionesses of the pride hunt in teams while the male lions stay and guard their land and cubs!
- Elephants have sensitive skin and will often use dirt, sand and mud as sunscreen to block out the sun!
- The flightless ostrich is the world's largest bird!

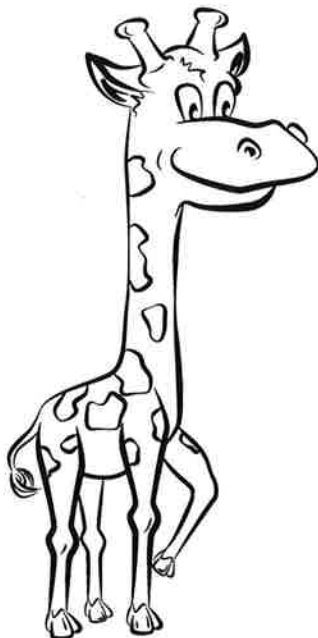


- The bright color of the flamingo is a result of their diet: shrimps, algae and crustaceans are responsible for the red and pink colors of their feathers!
- Giraffes spend much of their lives standing up, including when they sleep!
- A giraffe's spots are much like human fingerprints. No two individual giraffes have exactly the same pattern!
- The hippopotamus can hold its breath underwater for up to 30 minutes!
- African buffalo horns are shaped like question marks!
- Horns in some species of antelopes can grow up to 5 feet in length!
- South Africa is approximately 3 times the size of Texas!
- South Africa doesn't have just one official language - it has 11!

of the hunting.

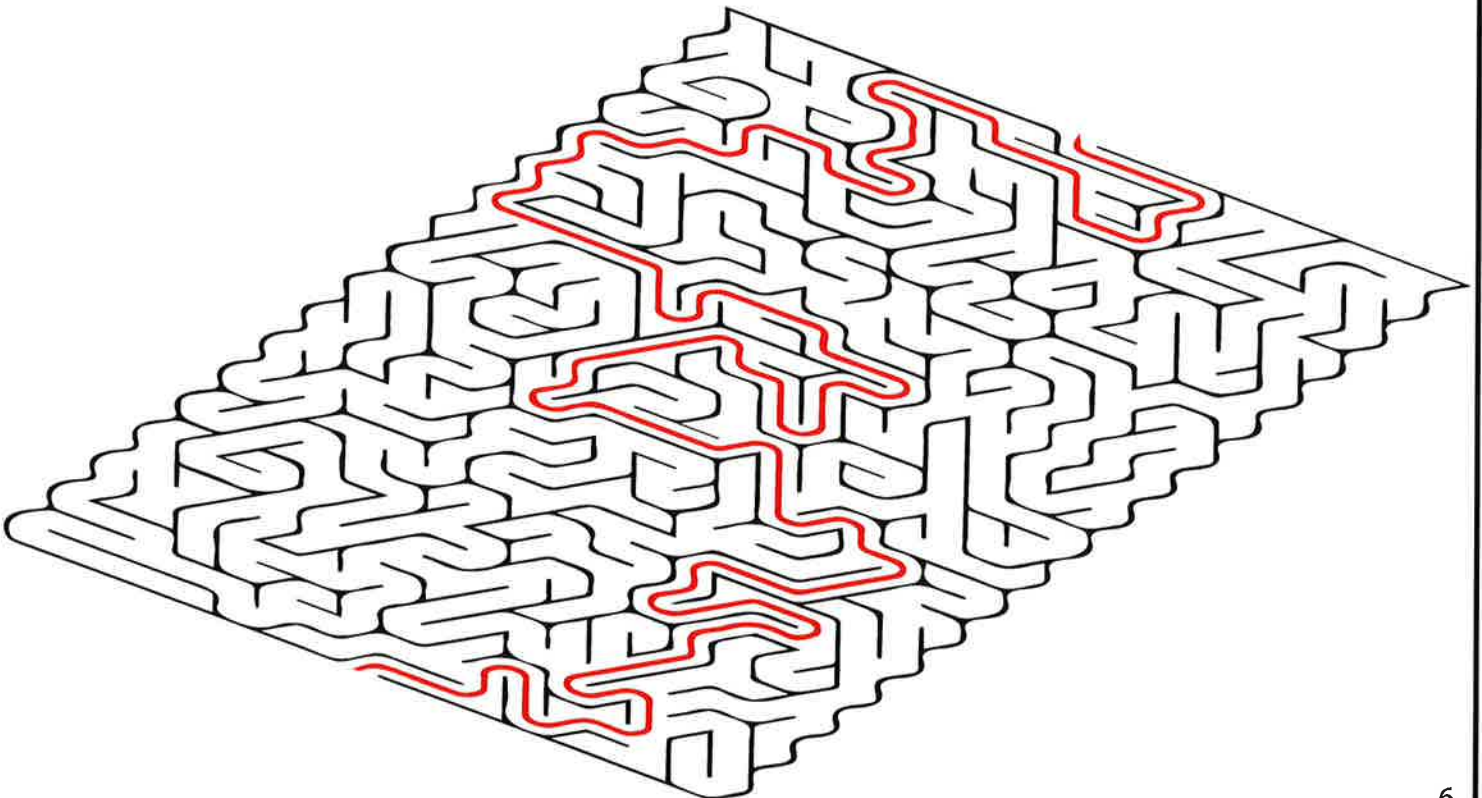
(It is true, females do most of the hunting, while the males are responsible for patrolling and guarding the pride's territory!)

(Despite being known as "the king of the jungle", the jungle is one of the few places you won't find lions living!)

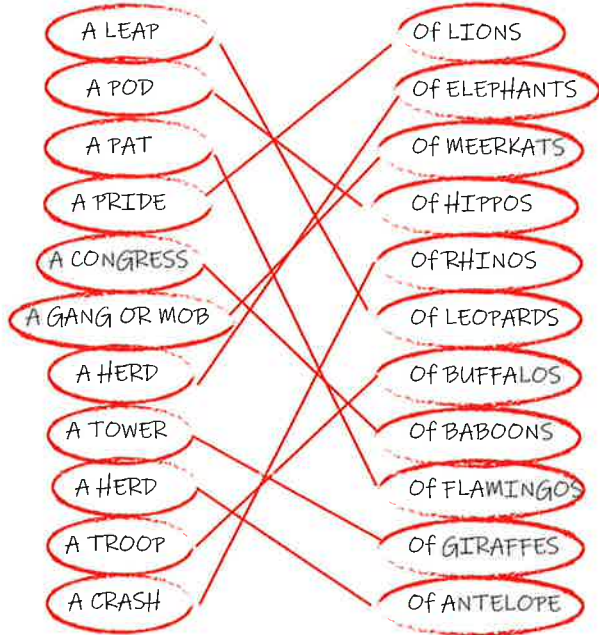
